- \$1.9 million to expand educational programs at B Street Theatre.

- \$14 million for a new Superior Courthouse in Sacramento's rail yards.

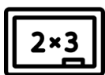
Requires the Attorney General to collect data on peace officer-involved shootings resulting in death or serious injury.

Fair Chance Act

Gives job seekers a fair chance at employment by prohibiting past conviction inquiry on initial applications.



Youth Voter Pre-Registration

Automatically registers 16 and 17 year olds to vote when they apply for a driver license or ID.



Opioid Addiction Treatment

Funds county addiction, prevention, intervention and rehabilitation programs to fight California's opioid epidemic.
